# 1758 DISCUSSION WITH DUNCAN TAYLOR, HULL UNIVERSITY TEACHING HOSPITAL NHS TRUST

Mr Taylor updated Cllrs on the changes needed on the Castle Hill site due to the day care surgery backlog caused by Covid. This requires new buildings in the short term but would lead to a reduction in the footprint of the site over the long term as old and temporary structures would be removed. The difficulties of parking on site were highlighted with park and rides, decked car parks, and parking charges being discussed.

Following Mr Taylor's departure, Cllr Cantrell asked if the Parish Council could meet with a representative from Unison to hear the staff point of view regarding parking.

### 1759 TO RECEIVE UPDATE/AGREE PATH CLEARANCE COSTS

Following the last meeting, the Clerk had contacted East Riding of Yorkshire Council to raise concerns regarding insurance and lack of cutting of the path running northwards from the Millbeck Wildlife Area. East Riding confirmed that cutting had taken place in the past and would do so this year however this was only surface vegetation and not overhanging hedges. This would be the responsibility of the owners of the adjacent land and if the Parish Council wished to undertake work to this, they should contact the owners and also ensure that anyone employed to carry out work had sufficient insurance.
